In Karoonda, leaving young children in someone else's care for more than one day per week has not been an option at all – until now. Faced with booming demand, the Karoonda District Council were keen to expand their service to cater for the local community.

The council recognised an opportunity to provide facilities for their community. The council successfully received funding via the Drought Relief Grant to support the project. Local government parties soon identified Ausco as the only company able to manage the whole job in-house, within the short 6-month time frame and to the budget.
